English oak oval work stool, circa 1870. The stool presents with an S-shaped piercing on the oval top. The apron shows a simple yet elegant arch cut-out design [1. The "arch cut-out" in the apron is a typical feature in stools of this period, providing both aesthetic and functional benefits, such as lightening the visual weight and offering an area for handgrip.] with turned legs exhibiting baluster-shaped profiles braced by a box stretcher with tapered supports.
