Pair of naturalistic curved cast stone faux bois benches [1. Faux bois had its beginnings in 1849 with the invention of reinforced concrete by Joseph Monier (1823-1906), a French gardener. He created concrete plant containers reinforced with wire and the genre soon spread throughout Europe, the Middle East, Japan, and Central and South America],
